Where to go once you arrive:

Parking

- Park your car in the Hospital Parking Garage or surface lot off Conway Road.
- We have some designated Maternity Welcome Center spots in the Hospital Garage

Maternity Welcome Center

- We ask ALL maternity patients and their family members to use the Main Entrance, open 24 hours-a-day..
- Maternity patients and their partner should check in at the Maternity Welcome Center located just inside the Main Entrance.
- Family members should use the Children's elevators when visiting Labor and Birth and the South Elevators for the Mother Baby area.

Pregnancy health concerns:

You may experience concerns about your health or the health of your baby during your pregnancy.

Call your physician immediately if:

- Vaginal bleeding occurs
- Your water breaks
- You have four to six contractions per hour or more before 37 weeks of pregnancy
- There is a major change in baby's movement
- Any of your body signals are of concern to you.
