### Mercy Kids

Mercy Kids in Springfield is home to more than 50 pediatric specialists whose areas of expertise include a range of services from hematology and oncology to neurosurgery, orthopedics, gastroenterology, behavioral health, psychiatry and more. ### Cancer Care

In 2014, Mercy Hospital Springfield became the third approved center in Missouri for a Left Ventricular Assist Device (LVAD) program for congestive heart failure. Mercy Hospital also has one of the nation's lowest readmission rates for heart attack and heart failure.

### Neurosciences and Stroke

Mercy's team of neuroscience experts provide unsurpassed stroke care for patients suffering from neurovascular diseases as well as brain, spine or skull-based tumors. As home to the region's only pediatric neurosurgeon, Mercy also provides compassionate care to infants through adolescents requiring neurosurgery or stroke treatment.
