
## High-Risk Pregnancy Care

Our Maternal-Fetal Health Centers, located in Creve Coeur and O'Fallon, Missouri, as well as Maryville, Illinois, provide high-risk pregnancy care 24/7. If your baby needs extra care, our team guides you through the process and connects you with pediatric specialists.

## Antepartum Care

Moms with high-risk pregnancies may need to be hospitalized on bedrest or limit their activities before delivery. Mercy's Antepartum Unit provides comprehensive care in comfortable surroundings for expectant women who experience:

- Pre-term labor (contractions before 37 weeks)
- Premature rupture of membranes
- Bleeding
- High blood pressure
- Diabetes
- Smaller-than-expected fetal growth
- Pregnancy with more than one baby
- Polyhydramnios (more than the expected amount of fluid around the baby)
- Ongoing hyperemesis (constant nausea and vomiting)





# Oh baby! It's time.

Here's our quick guide to where to go and what to do when you're in active labor. **Signs of active labor include:**

- Longer, stronger and more painful contractions that are three to five minutes apart
- Lower-back pressure or leg pain
- Feeling the urge to push
- Water breaking

## Your Arrival

Mercy Birthplace is located at 615 S. New Ballas Road in Creve Coeur.

## Parking

Park in the surface lot by the main entrance or in one of our hospital parking garages, where we have designated maternity parking spots.

## Maternity Welcome Center

Use the main entrance, which is open 24 hours. The Maternity Welcome Center will be immediately to your right. You'll check in and be evaluated in our OB Triage Unit, which features 12 private rooms.

## Your Birth Experience

You're in great hands at Mercy Birthplace. Whatever type of birth experience you choose, our experienced childbirth professionals provide exceptional care. Doulas and family members are welcome to be part of your birth experience.

### Labor & Birth Unit

Our highly trained Labor and Delivery nurses monitor your progress and provide expert care throughout your birth experience. Our first priority is keeping you and your baby safe. Anesthesiologists and certified nurse anesthetists are available 24/7 for pain management.

#### Amenities include:

- Spacious, all-private suites with soothing decor
- Multi-jet showers in all rooms, and whirlpool tubs in most suites
- Wireless, waterproof fetal monitors
- Birth balls and balance bars to enhance labor progress
- A generous fold-out couch for your birth partner
- An ergonomic recliner and footrest
- Flat-screen TVs
- Wi-Fi and work spaces for birth partners
- Nearby waiting areas for your loved ones
- Private rooms for cesarean birth preparation and recovery





### Low-Intervention Suites

For expectant parents who prefer a spontaneous, unmedicated birth we offer two low-intervention suites. These rooms have queen-size beds, hotel-inspired linens and extra space to move during labor. If you're considering this option, we encourage you to attend our Natural Childbirth Preparation classes.

### Mercy Birthing Center Midwifery Care

If you choose an unmedicated birth with care provided by certified nurse midwives, Mercy has an in-hospital, low-risk birthing center. The Birthing Center offers a home-like birth with the safety of hospital resources nearby.

### Level IV NICU

Many expectant parents find comfort in knowing that Mercy Birthplace has a Level IV NICU to address any newborn-related health concerns. Care is provided by Mercy Kids neonatologists and neonatal nurse practitioners.

## Your Hospital Stay

After delivery, your new family moves to a private room to recover and bond with your baby.

### Mother-Baby Unit

Nurses and certified lactation consultants support you with baby-care basics, including feeding, swaddling, diapering and bathing. Healthy moms and babies receive "couplet care," which keeps your baby close by and gives you confidence to care for your newborn at home.

### Amenities include:

- Light snacks, room service and a kitchen for new parents
- Space for your family members and visitors
- Sleeping accommodations for your birth partner
- Complimentary HALO sleep sacks for babies to support safe sleep
- Free Wi-Fi to connect you to family and friends


