**Emergency help** – prescriptive meds, limited rent, IDs, travel back home, bus passes, referrals to needed services, e.g., food pantries.

Birth certificates - IDs

**Entry essentials** – direct services for persons on state supervision, referred by parole officers.

**Vital papers** – Missouri/out-of-state birth certificates/IDs, GED tests, and Discretionary Sex Offender Assessments for Missouri parolees. 314-881-6034
