Missouri's Vaccines for Children Program

Children age 18 and below may be able to receive free vaccines. To qualify a child must be either:

- *Eligible for Medicaid*
- *Without health insurance*
- *Native American or Alaska Native, or*
- *Have health insurance, but it does not cover immunization, AND they go to a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) or Rural Health Center (RHC)*
