Video Visit How-to — MyMercy App



Thank you for choosing to visit your doctor through a MyMercy Video Visit. We have some helpful tips for your upcoming appointment.



Complete eCheck-in

eCheck-in can be completed up to seven days before your scheduled video visit.



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Find Good Natural Lighting

- This is best done by facing an open window in your home or even going outside.
- Good lighting is important for your health care provider to properly see you and assess your condition.



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Connecting and troubleshooting

- Connect to your appointment early and check to make sure you have a strong connection. We recommend connecting ten minutes before your scheduled visit.
- If you have any trouble connecting or any other issue, please check out the Video Visits Troubleshooting page through MyMercy, under Visit instructions.

- Now let's walk through a video visit and what to expect.
- Go to your MyMercy Mobile app and log in.
- Open the Visits & eCheck-in link.
- Select the video visit you wish to attend.
 - $_{\odot}$ You'll be able to see a list of the activities to complete your visit.
- If you haven't already, you'll need to go through the e-check in process to verify your medications, allergies and other important info.



- When you're ready to attend your visit, select **Begin visit** at the bottom of your screen. It may take 10 or more seconds to be placed in your virtual room, depending on your internet connection.
- You may notice the app switches to the web browser on your mobile device.
- You will be asked for access to your camera and microphone. Please select Allow.



- You will not be able to see yourself. At this point you can make any adjustments to your microphone and camera. If there are issues with your connection, a notice should appear at the bottom of the page.
- When you're ready to begin, click Join meeting.
- You'll be placed in the virtual exam room; your care team will join your visit shortly.



- You'll notice at the bottom of the screen you have several controls:
 - $_{\circ}~$ You can mute your microphone.
 - $_{\circ}~$ You can turn off your camera.
 - You can also choose to remove the self-view in the top left corner.
- Feel free to change the rotation of your device whenever needed.
- When both you and your provider agree to end the visit, you may do so by selecting the red icon at the bottom of your screen.
