Dr. Hollingsworth, and the rest of the Mercy Women's Center team, will be located in the cancer center upon completion. Their focus is to provide oversight for the entire breast care program. This includes risk assessment, genetic counseling, breast surgery and more.

He clearly has a vision for what can happen at the new cancer center. "There is still the potential to improve the care of the breast cancer patient. There is a definite advantage to centralization of breast care," said Dr. Hollingsworth.

A lot goes into the construction of a new building as big as the cancer center. Take a look at some of the numbers below. They are staggering!

- Total parking lot project includes spots for 852 vehicles
- The Cancer Center will be 86,000 square feet
- The building will include an additional 42,000 square feet of shell space for future growth
- The new lighting will use 1/3 less energy than a standard hospital
- Daylight, used extensively in this project, will help promote a healing environment
- Total soil moved is 15,000 cubic yards
