Requirements for Drop-Off

Officers of the law are the only people that have access to the medication once it is placed in the drop box.

Please use a black marker to cross out any identifying information on your pill bottles or place the pills in a plastic Ziploc bag before they go into the drop box.

Accepted items include:

- Prescription medications (including controlled substances)
- All over-the-counter medications
- Pet medications
- Vitamins and supplements
- Medicated ointments, lotions, creams, and oils
- Liquid medication in leak-proof containers
- Homeopathic and herbal remedies
- Suppositories

Items that will NOT be accepted include

- Illegal drugs
- Needles/sharps
- Syringes with needles
- Thermometers
- IV bags and tubing
- Bloody or infectious waste
- Personal care products
- Empty containers
- Hydrogen peroxide
- Aerosol cans
- Inhalers

You are encouraged to call first to see what time the offices take medication drop-offs.

Precaution: Expired, old, and/or unused medication should NOT be kept in your home, thrown in the garbage, or flushed down the toilet. To ensure the safety of you and your loved ones, and the environment, please drop off your old and expired medications and prescriptions at one of these sites.
