



USEFUL ITEMS TO HAVE AVAILABLE AFTER SURGERY

Loose fitting clothes -- such as drawstring or elastic waist pants.

Polysporin or Neosporin ointment -- to be applied the end of your penis where the catheter comes out.

Supply of adult diapers or pull ups -- (ATTENDS or DEPENDS) that can be purchased at many stores (i.e. Walmart, Walgreens, Kmart, drug stores, etc.).

Brief-style underwear -- this type of underwear, will help hold a pad in place and also give better support. Boxer shorts are less helpful.

Stool softener -- Colace, Pericolace, Senekot S (over-the-counter).

Milk of Magnesia (MOM), Dulcolax laxative pills (not softener), Magnesium Citrate-- for constipation.

Aleve (naprosyn, naproxen) 220 mg or Ibuprofen 200 mg (Advil, Motrin, etc.). – for pain, swelling, and in place of or in addition to narcotic pain medications.

Tylenol (acetaminophen) – for pain in place of narcotic pain medications.
