



## ***What you should know about REFRACTIONS***

When your vision is measured for glasses the process is called a **Refraction**. Refraction is one of the most important parts of your eye examination today. It is the part of the examination by which we determine whether your vision can be made better by providing a new glasses prescription for you. This test can also be used diagnostically to determine the best possible visual acuity and function of your eye. This is essential medical information for us to assess your vision and look for potential problems. Without it, we may not be able to fully evaluate the health and function of your eyes.

Many insurance plans do not cover the service fee for the refraction. Our fee for refraction is \$30 and is due at the time of your visit if the doctor releases the prescription to you. Otherwise, we will submit the refraction to your insurance company and you may receive a bill for this service if it is not covered.
